Angel City Chorale is proud to represent the spirit and diversity of Los Angeles in our membership, our music, and our outreach activities, thereby fulfilling our motto to "Build Community One Song at a Time." Celebrated Artistic Director Sue Fink founded the Chorale at the world-famous McCabe's Guitar Shop in 1993 with 18 singers. The chorale has now grown to over 160 talented and dedicated singers, presenting a broad and eclectic repertoire including classical, gospel, pop, and world music.



Angel City Chorale is perhaps best known for our performances on NBC's top-rated talent competition America's Got Talent (2018), advancing to the semi-finals.

Hailed by Simon Cowell as "one of the best choirs we've ever had," the Chorale earned the coveted Golden Buzzer, touching nearly 20 million viewers with a rich sound and compelling message of unity and diversity.

AUDIENCE AND MEMBERSHIP

In the post-COVID era, we are fighting to bring back our members and to reclaim our audience in a safe environment. While we want more patrons and members to attend live shows, we understand the value and need for virtual options to stay true to our vision. Our dedicated COVID compliance volunteers have guarded the safety of the chorale, and no incidents of COVID have been linked to ACC rehearsals or performances.

In 2021, ACC began focusing on marketing and partnered with a local agency to build awareness and reach a broader audience through branding, clear messaging, and leveraging social media platforms. In 2022, we hired a marketing director to build more cohesive campaigns with consistent messaging, and to improve internal and external communication. Through these efforts, our membership rose to 180, and we nearly sold out 2 live shows for our 2022 holiday season.

Angel City Chorale has performed 500+ songs in 20 languages in more than 250 concerts around the world.

ANGEL CITY YOUTH CHORALE

Angel City Youth Chorale (ACYC) launched in 2019 through a partnership with the Boys and Girls Club (B&GC), and more than 125 children ages 6 to 14 have participated in 7 concerts since inception. ACYC persevered through the pandemic with virtual rehearsals and performed using ASL in "PLAY IT FORWARD," featuring member of the B&GC Deaf and Hard of Hearing group on "ONE VOICE." ACYC partnered with 4 additional communities in Fall 2021 growing to 50 members. There are plans to build on this music education opportunity to reach more youth in the LA area.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH & TOUR OF HOPE

Since 1998, ACC has brought the holidays to hospitals, shelters, and senior living communities with our annual Tour of Hope. The pandemic limited our ability to tour; however, in 2021, we expanded our outreach efforts and mobilized a free concert at the Veterans' Home in Brentwood and held successful food drives, collecting and donating food to several local food reception centers in Los Angeles. We expanded our efforts in 2022 with a Red Cross Blood Drive; a Habitat for Humanity food and school supply drive; free live and virtual performances including telecasts through Front Porch; a World Singing Day Video; a West Coast Cares event for the homeless; and the Homeboy Industries 10th Annual Holiday CARnival performance for ex-gang members and their families.

DIVERSITY, EQUITY, AND INCLUSION

Angel City Chorale created our Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion (DEI) Committee in 2020 whose purpose is to assist with music choices, music research, member and audience recruitment, and visibility. The committee strives to ensure that the chorale is aware of and responsive to the viewpoints and sensitivities of the diverse groups within ACC which have enriched our performances and our sense of community. DEI administered a demographic survey in 2021 to explore ways to reach more communities in Los Angeles. We shared the garnered insights internally and brainstormed ways to build our membership and audience. DEI is now represented in all of our committees and provides an avenue for members to voice concerns and share ideas.



REVENUE FY2021




