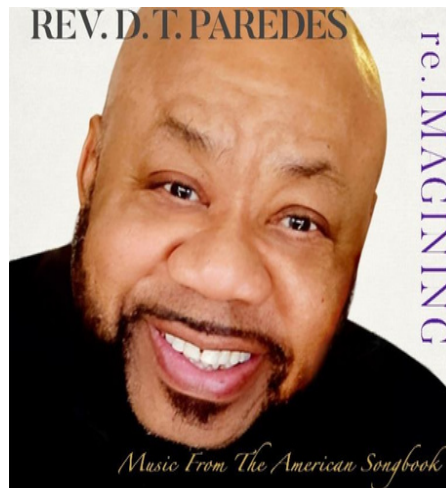

Marcia Harris Howard:

A Legacy of Generosity and Passion for the Arts

Marcia Harris Howard was a devoted supporter of Angel City Chorale (ACC) and a cherished member of its community. As the inaugural member of the ACC Legacy Society, she made an extraordinary gift through her estate planning that sustained the chorale during challenging times, including the COVID-19 pandemic and beyond. Marcia's generosity and foresight have left an enduring impact, ensuring that ACC continues to bring joy and inspiration to future generations.

A true Renaissance woman, Marcia's life was rich with music, literature, theatre, travel, culinary arts, and a deep engagement with world affairs. Beyond her contributions to ACC, Marcia was a steadfast supporter of her alma mater, UCLA, and her Beverly Hills community. She served on numerous UCLA boards and committees. Her philanthropic spirit led her to endow a Chair in Literary Studies, which helped establish UCLA's Creative Writing Program.

Marcia's love of literature was unparalleled. She was a passionate reader and a founding board member of the Beverly Hills Literary Society, where she nurtured her love for storytelling and ideas.

Marcia took immense pride in her cousin, Sue Fink, the founder and Artistic Director of Angel City Chorale, regularly attending the chorale's bi-annual concerts. She believed deeply in the transformative power of the arts and dedicated herself to ensuring their continued impact on both performers and audiences alike.

Angel City Chorale is forever grateful for Marcia Harris Howard's unwavering support, visionary generosity, and boundless enthusiasm for life and the arts. Her legacy will continue to inspire and uplift for generations to come.

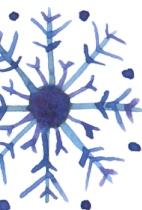
