	Do not list the composer's name on the score or anywhere in the .pdf file.
	Note on the first page of your score if the text is original, public domain or a copyrighted text, accompanied by a letter of permission from the copyright owner.
	For non-English texts, include a translation and pronunciation guide.
	You may include a written statement (up to 300 words) about the composition, the compositional process, or other relevant information about the piece for potential marketing or promotional purposes. The statement will not be shared with the judges during the evaluation process.

☐ The file name of the .mp3 must only contain the title and estimated performance duration of the composition (e.g., "CommonGround_4.50").

- Compositions will be reviewed by a third party to ensure they have met all competition requirements. Entries not conforming to the requirements will be rejected.
